Oxford University Press	OUP and a number of Lebanese institutions affiliated with the Lebanese Academic Library Consortium, LALC (LAU is a part of LALC) have agreed a Read and Publish deal. Eligible authors from participating institutions in Lebanon can request use of this account to pay the Open Access charge when arranging payment in OUP's online licensing and payment system. <p>American Chemical Society (ACS)</p>	<p>ACS offers significantly discounted APC prices to papers in ACS fully open access journals whose submitting corresponding authors are based in countries classified by the World Bank as low-income economies as of August 2024.</p> <p>Special country prices apply to publications in ACS fully open access journals only. <p>American Medical Association (AMA)</p>	<p>"Lebanon is currently designated as a Group A country by Hinari which means manuscripts submitted from Lebanon would have the OA APC fees waived, if a manuscript is accepted for publication from your institution".</p>	<p>https://www.research4life.org/access/eligibility/</p>
<p>American Society for Civil Engineers (ASCE)</p>	<p>ASCE OPEN : Multidisciplinary Journal of Civil Engineering is a Gold Open Access journal with an APC of USD 2,000. Authors from Lebanon can publish for free through ASCE's APC waiver program, which is based on geographic eligibility and lack of other funding. Lebanese authors can apply by contacting articlewaiver@asce.org.</p> <p>All other ASCE journals are hybrid, with optional Open Access at APCs of USD 3,000 (CC BY) or USD 2,750 (CC BY-NC-ND). <p>Elsevier</p>	<p>Waivers for Article Processing Charges (APCs) apply to Gold Open Access journals when all authors are based in a Research4Life-eligible country.</p> <p>This waiver does not apply to Hybrid journals; authors can publish under the subscription model at no cost and use Elsevier’s sharing policy.</p> <p>300 Gold Open Access journals are excluded from the Research4Life waiver and fall under the GPOA Pilot where APCs are adjusted by country. <p>Royal Society of Chemistry</p>	<p>Lebanese authors are eligible to receive a full APC waiver in the gold open-access journals as per RSC : "If you are based in a country classified as Group A or Group B by Research4Life, and you are the corresponding author, you are eligible to receive a full APC waiver in our gold open access journals. <p>Sage</p>	<p>The R4L scheme only applies to Gold APCs at Sage. Please see the current guidance here: Gold Open Access Article Processing Charge Waivers SAGE Publications Inc.</p> <p>Corresponding Authors who are affiliated with institutions in countries, areas and territories in Research4Life’s Group A reside in Lebanon publishing in one of Sage’s gold open access journals will automatically receive a full APC waiver without needing to take any action. The waiver will be applied based on the Corresponding Author affiliation in Sage Journals: Licensing & Payment.</p> <p>If the author has declared LAU as their affiliation, the waiver will be applied automatically based on the country.</p>	<p>Gold Open Access Article Processing Charge Waivers SAGE Publications Inc.</p>

N.B. The list above (APC waivers automatically available) is not comprehensive, as every publisher has different procedures and processes. The library's role is limited to APCs that are part of transformative agreements and/or agreements with publishers. Our search focused on publishers with whom we subscribe to content; however, faculty also have opportunities to publish with publishers whose content we do not subscribe to. Therefore, we recommend that concerned faculty members check the publisher's website by searching for the publisher name and "APC Waiver" to access the necessary information.
